

Thy Kingdom Come:
VISION AND
CREATION HAVE
AN APPOINTMENT
PART 2

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Habakkuk 2:1-4

1 I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reprov'd.

2 And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.

3 For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

- Here in keeping with vision, Habakkuk moves to a place of elevation, a place of intimacy, a place of privacy, with anticipation to hear, see, and perceive from God.
- Watch to see what he will say in vision. To hear is an opportunity to see from the perspective of the spirit and glance into a new reality, understanding that he needed to see something different in these troubling times.
- He's saying, "It is the place where I am willing to be addressed, to be corrected, and even reproved in order to set myself in alignment with the purpose and plan of God."

- Writing the vision transfers the vision from the supernatural to the natural. The vision needs to be clear, concise, and compelling so that it will affect those who receive it.
- He also makes it clear that every vision has an appointed time of manifestation in the life of the believer. It is a process and its fulfillment will be sure even though it will cause you to wait for its manifestation.

Galatians 4:4-5


4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,
5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

In Habakkuk God reveals the nature and dynamics of a vision:

1. He talks about an elevated mindset
2. The ability to watch and receive
3. The ability to make adjustments and be reproved when necessary
4. Write the vision down, impregnate our words with what we see
5. Make sure the vision is clear for others to receive it
6. Remember that the vision has an appointment
7. But at the end it will produce proof if you wait on it
8. Vision demands a faith walk

Ephesians 1:10-11


10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:
11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

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- The purposes of God are always now, yea and amen, but in the reality of mankind, we are limited by times and seasons.
 - The fulfillment in the context of our lives is the fact that it will surely come to pass.
 - Know that it is always pre ordered, pre-determined, and prescribed as God works all things after the purpose of his will.

Acts 1:7-8

7 And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.

8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
