Deuteronomy 30:11-16

11 For this commandment which I command thee this day, it is not hidden from thee, neither is it far off.

12 It is not in heaven, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it?


13 Neither is it beyond the sea, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go over the sea for us, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it?

14 But the word is very nigh unto thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart, that thou mayest do it.

Deuteronomy 30:11-16

15 See, I have set before thee this day life and good, and death and evil;


16 In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

- There are laws upon which the kingdom functions in the life of a believer.
 - Those laws and principles are spiritual laws that function through the spirit of faith.
 - It is not an issue of physical location. But in reality, it is the power that resides within you and the result of the power of the word.
 - It is the word that is even in your mouth, the source being a result of what is in the heart.
 - Faith in the heart must be walked out in practice in order to live, multiply and see the blessings of the Lord.

3 John 2

2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

- Your life can only prosper to the extent your soul prospers.
- Your money can only prosper to the extent your soul prospers.
- Your relationships can only prosper to the extent your soul prospers.
- Your health can only prosper to the extent your soul prospers.

- These laws and principles in our heart should be the reason our soul prospers.
 - The soul is the source of our mind; it is where our personality, thinking, and mentality should be changed in order for prosperity to be the end result.

John 6:63

63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

- It is only the thing that is produced from the spirit that produces life; and there is nothing in the flesh but death.
- When we speak from our circumstances, we speak from the place of death.
- When we speak from our vision, we speak words of life.
- Jesus' words were pregnant with his vision of the kingdom, which produced healing, salvation, prosperity, and a new life in the kingdom.

Mark 11:22-26

22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God.**

23 **For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.**

24 **Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

25 **And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.**

26 **But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.**

- Jesus says, ‘whatsoever you say,’ but remember it is not just what you say, it’s what you say it from.
- Where do your words come from? Idle words are empty words void of revelation, inspiration, and power.
- ‘Whatsoever you desire...,’ but where does that desire come from? Does it come out of the selfish desires of the flesh or does it come out of the desire to serve God and bless others?
- Whatsoever you say and desire has to be stronger than your doubt. It takes real faith to overcome the facts of life that show you a different picture than what you believe.
- When your desire is passionate enough, big enough, driven enough, you are unstoppable.

Hebrews 11:17-22

17 By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son,

18 Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called:

19 Accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.

20 By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.

21 By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, leaning upon the top of his staff.

22 By faith Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment concerning his bones.

- In everyone of these circumstances, faith is exhibited through actions that would be contrary to reasonable behavior.
- This means that those who operated by faith were a unique breed. Not everyone could be trusted to believe God to the extent that their obedience was never a question.
- You cannot walk in powerful faith and walk in disobedience at the same time.
- To believe God is to trust God. To believe God is to have confidence in God. To believe God is to obey God. To believe God is to past the test and earn the next level of power.

James 1:5-8

5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.

- Faith is not compatible with ignorance. Ignorant people will never create anything of any substance.
- Ignorant people are void of a balanced understanding of God and pervert it to their own benefit, so they think.
- Ignorant people are not aware that God is not mocked. You will always reap the consequences of operating outside of faith.
- That which is not sown in faith will produce life.
- That which is sown in the flesh will produce death.
- Words are just seeds, pregnant with life through faith or death by the flesh.

Psalms 37:4-5

4 Delight thyself also in the Lord ; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

5 Commit thy way unto the Lord ; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

- The word 'delight' in the Hebrew language means to be pliable, tender, soft, yielded. It means to show affection.
- It means to engage, to be like the bride who is excited about the fact that anytime the groom will show up. She looks forward to be in his presence. She can't wait for his embrace. She looks forward to his kisses and the blessings he will bring.

Psalms 35:27-28

27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

28 And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness and of thy praise all the day long.
